

342.228 Responsibilities of Office of Workers' Claims -- Selection and qualifications of executive director.

- (1) The Office of Workers' Claims shall be responsible for administering claims and ensuring compliance with the insurance, self-insurance, and rehabilitation provisions in this chapter. The office shall be administered by an executive director appointed by the Governor. The Governor shall select the executive director from a list of three (3) names submitted by the Workers' Compensation Nominating Commission created pursuant to KRS 342.213. The executive director appointed by the Governor shall be subject to the consent of the Senate in accordance with KRS 11.160.
- (2) The executive director shall have demonstrated knowledge and experience in the area of workers' compensation, public administration, and administrative law.
