

438.317 Prohibitions against sale of or making available cigarettes packaged in units of fewer than twenty -- Penalties.

- (1) No person shall sell or cause to be sold at retail cigarettes packaged in units of fewer than twenty (20) cigarettes.
- (2) No resident wholesaler, nonresident wholesaler, or subjobber shall make available to a retail establishment cigarettes packaged for retail sale in units of less than twenty (20) cigarettes.
- (3) Any person violating subsection (1) of this section shall be subject to a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500). Any person violating subsection (2) of this section shall be fined not less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) nor more than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500). These penalties shall be enforced by the Office of Alcoholic Beverage Control through civil enforcement procedures.
