

CHAPTER 62**(HB 89)**

AN ACT relating to reorganization.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

Section 1. The General Assembly hereby confirms Executive Order 2000-1502, dated November 28, 2000, which changes the name of the Division of Clinical Services to the Division of Care Coordination and creates the Division of Medical Services within the Commission for Children with Special Health Care Needs. The Division of Care Coordination shall be responsible for all program functions previously performed by the Division of Clinical Services with the exception of the Hematology Branch which shall be administered by the Division of Medical Services. The Division of Medical Services shall be responsible for the Hematology and the newly established Universal Newborn Hearing Screening programs of the Commission for Children with Special Health Care Needs. Functions shall include administration of programs for bleeding disorders, such as hemophilia and sickle cell disease, and the statewide Universal Newborn Hearing Screening initiative.
