

322.050 Requirements for applicants.

To be eligible for licensure, an applicant shall be of good character and reputation. No applicant shall be eligible who:

- (1) Has been convicted of any felony involving moral turpitude, fraud, or deceit;
- (2) Engages in conduct likely to deceive or defraud the public; or
- (3) Is adjudged mentally disabled by a court of competent jurisdiction.
